JOINT JUDICIAL CENTER AND CIRCUIT COURTS DELAYED OPENING

Due to impending weather conditions which constitute a threat to the safety of the Clerk's Office personnel and to the general public, it is ORDERED that the Clerks of the Circuit Courts of the City of Winchester and Frederick County are authorized to delay the opening of their offices and the opening of the Joint Judicial Center (JJC) shall be **delayed on February 6, 2025** until 9:00 a.m. and the Circuit Court Clerks' offices will remain open until the regular 4:00 p.m. closing time for those offices.


It is further ordered that commencement of the February 6, 2025 Frederick County **Circuit Court** docket is delayed until **9:30 a.m.**

The Winchester/Frederick County **Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court** has ordered that its docket will begin at **9:00 a.m.** on February 6, 2025.

The Winchester/Frederick County **General District Court** has ordered that its docket will begin at **9:30 a.m.** on February 6, 2025.

This order is entered pursuant to the provisions of Virginia Code Section 17.1-207(3) and shall have the effect with respect to judicial proceedings as prescribed by Virginia Code Section 1-210.
